MEMORANDUM DECISION AND ORDER  
DISMISSING MOTION FOR CONTINUATION OF AUTOMATIC STAY

On January 31, 2020, the debtor filed the petition commencing this case and filed a *Motion for Continuation of Automatic Stay* (Dkt. No. 5) but failed to upload a proposed order including a "Copies to" section as required by LBR 9072-1(b)(3), or file a notice of a 17-day opportunity to oppose the motion, as required by LBR 9013-1. The Clerk issued notices informing the debtor of these deficiencies, but the debtor has not responded. The debtor has also failed to file a notice of a hearing. It would be difficult to put the *Motion* back on track procedurally: a motion like this, under 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(3)(B), must be heard within 30 days after the commencement of the case.

In any event, I will dismiss the *Motion for Continuation of Automatic Stay* as unnecessary. The debtor's only prior case was
